Lenten Reflections from the Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk, England

Week 1: Fr. Henry Whisenant, Diocese of East Anglia, and Chaplain for the Extraordinary Form at Our Lady Immaculate and St. Edmund’s, Withermarsh Green, shares the theme of the first week of Lent, commemorating Christ’s forty-day fast in the desert.

Week 2: Fr. Michael Rear of the Diocese of East Anglia, shares the theme of the second week of Lent, the offer of Abraham to sacrifice his only son Isaac and the implications of the Transfiguration of Our Lord.

Week 3: Fr. Colin Mary Edwards, OFM Conv., of the Catholic National Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham, shares the theme of the third week of Lent, Our Lord’s cleansing of the temple.

Week 4: Mgr. Philip Moger, Rector of the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, shares the theme of the fourth week of Lent, that of making new beginnings in the spiritual life and attempting to return God’s love as he deserves as our Creator, Redeemer and Sanctifier.

Week 5: Fr. Michael Rear of the Diocese of East Anglia shares the theme of the fifth Sunday of Lent, that the New Covenant has been inaugurated with the Passion, death and resurrection of Christ, open to gentiles as well as Jews. Jesus is the Savior of all mankind.

Week 6: Fr. John Delaney, OFM Conv. stationed at the National Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham, shares on Passion Sunday, giving an impassioned meditation on the Holy Face of Jesus as represented on Veronica’s Veil, especially evidenced in the revelations of Jesus to Sr. Mary of St. Peter, OCD.

Lent: A Season of Grace with Fr. Cedric Pisegna

Week 1: Fr. Cedric explains how true change can only come from asking for God's Grace, and not through grit alone.

Week 2: Fr. Cedric revisits the moment of The Transfiguration and shows how Catholics can get a glimpse of this Glory during Lent.
