Lenten Reflections from the Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk, England

Week 1: Fr. Colin Mary Edwards, OFM Conv., serving at the Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, shares the theme of the first week of Lent, describing the temptations of Jesus in the desert.

Week 2: Our Lenten Encounter with God. Fr. Andrew Starkie shares the theme of the second week of Lent, understanding the Transfiguration of Our Lord as the focus of our Lenten journey--to encounter God.

Week 3: Jesus Offers Living Water. On the third week of Lent, Fr. Mark Elliot Smith shares the encounter of Jesus with the Samaritan woman at the well, in which he offers her the living water of salvation.

Week 4: Light Alone Can Help Us. On the fourth week of Lent, Fr. Benedict Kiely shares the healing of the man born blind, relating how Jesus brought physical and spiritual light into the man's life.

Week 5: Christ Gives Lazarus New Life. On the fifth Sunday of Lent, Fr. Simon Ellis shares the story of Lazarus who begged in life and was received into the bosom of Abraham, as well as the raising from the dead of Lazarus the brother of Mary and Martha. In Baptism, Confession and Communion, Christians receive into their lives today the benefits of Christ's cross and resurrection.

Week 6, Palm Sunday: Celebrating the Passion and Death of Our Lord. Monsignor Keith Newton looks to St. Paul's Epistle to the Philippians, relating how Christ in his boundless divine love accepted death on the cross to bring everyone to salvation

Lent: A Season of Grace with Fr. Cedric Pisegna

Episode 1: The first week of Lent: Lent: A time of conversion:

The first week of Lent invites us to go deeper. Lent is a season of grace. Our goal is purification and enlightenment. Like Jesus we journey to the desert and experience conversion: movement towards God.

Episode 2: The second week of Lent: Be Enlightened:

The second week of Lent we journey from the desert to the mountaintop. This vision gives us a compass for the direction we are heading. Jesus' transfiguration fortifies us to face our difficulties. We come to a new identity as we discover our divine self also.

Episode 3: From Sir to Savior: The Samaritan woman at the well met Jesus and experienced illumination. She came to know Jesus as the one who brings abundant life, as savior. During Lent we all journey with the OCIA elect towards enlightenment.

Episode 4: Sight and Insight: Blindness in the Bible always refers to both a physical and spiritual condition. All of us have blind spots. Jesus comes to give us insight regarding our inner issues, judgments and intimacy with God. Jesus is the light of the world bringing new vision.

Episode 5: Rise!: Death is our ultimate enemy. Because of Jesus, not even death can separate us from the love of God. Death has been defeated. We can experience resurrection even now. In Jesus we can Rise and experience victory in every area of our life.

Episode 6: Passion Sunday: The cross is the crux of Christianity. Jesus suffered and died for all people. Through faith in his sacrifice we can experience the forgiveness of our sins and salvation. Believe and receive!
