

Lenten Reflections from St. Dominic's Priory in London England SUNDAYS @ 5:00 am & 4:30 pm

Episode 1: Man Does Not Live on Bread Alone: From the Holy Rosary Shrine at St. Dominic's Priory in London, Fr. Nicholas Crowe, O.P., Prior Provincial of the English Province, shares the theme of the first week of Lent, Jesus teaching his disciples to overcome temptation by focusing on God and serving him only.

Episode 2: This Is My Beloved Son: From Buckfast Abbey in Buckfast, near Buckfastleigh, Devon, England, Fr. Samuel Burke, O.P., of the Priory of St. Albert the Great in Edinburgh and Royal Navy Chaplain, shares the theme of the second week of Lent, the Transfiguration of the Lord revealing the identity and kingship of Jesus.

Episode 3 Jesus Offers Living Water:

From Holy Cross Leicester, Fr. John Church, O.P., of Holy Cross Priory in Leicester, shares in the third week of Lent the conversation between Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well, where Jesus offers eternal wisdom to live by.

Episode 4: The Great Gifts of Baptism: From the Holy Rosary Shrine at St. Dominic's Priory in London, Fr. Albert Robertson, O.P., Assistant Chaplain at Cambridge University and doctoral student at Emmanuel College, Cambridge, shares on the fourth week of Lent the healing of the man born blind as a metaphor for baptism, giving gifts of healing, reconciliation and illumination.

Episode 5: The Resurrection and the Life: From Holy Cross Leicester, Fr. John Farrell, O.P., of Holy Cross Priory in Leicester, shares on the fifth Sunday of Lent the account of the raising of Lazarus from the dead as evidence of the divine power of Jesus as the Resurrection and the Life.

Episode 6 The Triumphal Entry and His Saving Passion: From Holy Cross Leicester, Fr. Richard Ounsworth, Prior and Parish Priest at Holy Cross Priory, Leicester, lecturer in Scripture at Blackfriars Oxford, and editor of Torch, shares on Palm Sunday the themes of the two Gospel readings read on Palm Sunday, that of the triumphal entry of Our Lord into Jerusalem and his saving Passion.

Lent: A Season of Grace with Fr. Cedric Pisegna

Episode 1: Lent: A time of conversion: The first week of Lent invites us to go deeper. Lent is a season of grace. Our goal is purification and enlightenment. Like Jesus, we journey to the desert and experience conversion: movement towards God.

Episode 2: Be Enlightened: In the second week of Lent, we journey from the desert to the mountaintop. This vision gives us a compass for the direction we are heading. Jesus' transfiguration fortifies us to face our difficulties. We come to a new identity as we discover our divine self also.

Episode 4: Sight and Insight: Blindness in the Bible always refers to both a physical and spiritual condition. All of us have blind spots. Jesus comes to give us insight regarding our inner issues, judgments and intimacy with God. Jesus is the light of the world bringing new vision.

Episode 5: Rise!: Death is our ultimate enemy. Because of Jesus, not even death can separate us from the love of God. Death has been defeated. We can experience resurrection even now. In Jesus we can Rise and experience victory in every area of our life.

Episode 6, Passion Sunday: The cross is the crux of Christianity. Jesus suffered and died for all people. Through faith in his sacrifice, we can experience the forgiveness of our sins and salvation. Believe and receive!
